## 2011 Trip Sign-Up Now Open

At long last we've secured the lodgings, done the math and declared prices for next season's trips. This year's schedule has all the makings of a banner year. All we need, now, is for Mother Nature to do her share.

So, what does that mean for you? It means that you can finally pull out your checkbook and send off your deposits for 2011 season trips. (And we just know that you've been waiting with baited breath for this opportunity!)

As of now, you can begin sending in your deposits. Remember:

- You must be a member to participate in club trips.
- We require those making reservations for ski trips to remit the full amount of the advertised deposit.
  - For any trip that is overbooked by deposits postmarked prior to October 1 (an unusual situation), a lottery, drawn at the Ox Roast event, will determine who will be included on the trip.
  - After this, reservations will be handled on a first come, first served basis. This allows everyone an equal opportunity to get on the list to participate in all trips.
- All trip payments are to be paid to the Treasurer, not to the Trip Leader. You can give the Treasurer a check at a meeting or mail it to the club address at PO Box 1353, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055.
- Please contact the trip leader for additional information on the nature of skiing opportunities, accommodations and other questions.
- Details of how the Club's trip finances work are posted under the "Trip Finances" link on the Club's website.

## Adding Spice to Your Skiing

It is often said that "The only certainty is change." Planning and scheduling next season's trips were a bit challenging. What with our discovery of new ski destinations, changes in members' ski trip preferences and the loss of traditional lodging, we ended up with several interesting changes.

First, the **Pioneer Lodge, Turin, NY**, is no longer in business but the skiing venues in the area are as inviting as ever. We'll return to the area twice next year, but the trips will have a new name, **Tug Hill East**, and we'll have "sort of" new digs. We've used the **Allegro Guest House** in the past but as a B&B. The owners, Char & Denny, proposed that we take the whole house. That way we can save a few bucks and cook our own meals. And the owners will get a respite from host duties. A win-win situation to be sure!

We'll use new lodging for the **Laurentians** trip, too. It's not that Parker's Lodge went out of business, but, the trip was a tad pricey. This year we've identified a group of condos and we've reserved three of them. Located between val David and St Agathe, they are actually more centrally located to ski venues. We'll work meals like we do for Inlet and North Conway. Oh, did I mention that the price is reduced? Like down \$180 for this six-night trip!

We've been experimenting with new Vermont trip locations the past couple of years and we're trying another new destination next year. We stumbled upon the lovely town of **Middlebury, VT, and the Waybury Inn** (used for outdoor location shots on The Bob Newhart Show) while driving between other Vermont trips. With two excellent ski centers and lots of backcountry opportunities, it was a no-brainer.

Skiing "**Hut to Hut**" ... the term conjures up notions of deep woods adventures with romantic B&B interludes. In reality, that's actually tougher to arrange than you might think. However, the organization named **Maine Huts & Trails** is beginning to make it happen. Their three, new, off-the-grid huts are spaced about ten miles apart. They are connected by groomed, river-valley trails and have many other side trails to ski. Breakfasts and dinners are provided. It's about as close to the ideal as you can get. We're looking forward to this unique, week-long skiing opportunity!

Finally, Jean Geiger and Nancy Borremans got wind of the ski opportunities in the area of beautiful **Lake Louise in Canada's Banff National Park** and nearby **Kananaskis**. They've used these locations and excellent hostel facilities to structure what promises to be the ski trip highlight of our 2011 season!

So, add a little spice to your xc-skiing life by trying one of the new or revamped trips this year!
